Instructions for Intervention in Public Space

How to Organize a Life Drawing Class Using the Police as Models During the Occupation

1. Go to the occupation with a pad of paper, drawing supplies, clips, and a pile of boards to draw on.
2. Find a location with clear visibility of policeman/policewomen.
3. Set up your supplies.
4. If people want to join in, give them a board.
5. Draw the police.

You don't need to antagonize the police.

Just return their attentive gaze of surveillance with yours, paying attention to more subtle things: shapes, color, light, shadow, line, etc.
